ADVANCED SOLAR PRODUCTS SUES FORMER EMPLOYEE MIKE STRIZKI AND RENEWABLE ENERGY HOLDING INC. FOR MISAPPROPRIATION OF TRADE SECRETS AND CONFIDENTIAL AND PROPRIETARY INFORMATION CONCERNING ADVANCED SOLAR'S "SOLSTICE" SOLAR MOUNTING SYSTEM, AND SELLING A COMPETING "GENMOUNTS" SYSTEM DERIVED FROM THE WRONGFULLY MISAPPROPRIATED INFORMATION.

September 30, 2011. Advanced Solar Products ("ASP"), a leading engineering, procurement and construction firm for photovoltaic energy generation systems based in Flemington New Jersey today announced that it has filed a ten-count complaint in New Jersey Superior Court against Mike Strizki and Renewable Energy Holding, Inc., both of Hopewell NJ. The complaint alleges that Strizki and his company misappropriated Advanced Solar Products' confidential and proprietary trade secret information related to Advanced Solar Products' "Solstice" mounting system, and engaged in unfair competitive activities by marketing a competing mounting system based on the misappropriated information.

ASP further alleges that Strizki breached his fiduciary duty and duty of loyalty to Advanced Solar Products and that Strizki and Renewable Energy Holding Inc. interfered with Advanced Solar Products' prospective contractual relationships and unjustly enriched themselves, all in violation of New Jersey law.

Advanced Solar Products seeks money damages and injunctive relief.

As set forth in the Complaint, Advanced Solar Products has invested substantial time, money and effort into the development of its intellectual property and is dedicated to aggressively defending its rights against any entity which infringes those rights.
